2. Leadership Perspective (Introduction)

Our journey this year has been guided by the philosophy of "We Create Examples". Under the legal framework of registration F/2829/KUTCH, WDM continues to bridge the gap between rural potential and modern opportunity. We operate from our headquarters, "**Mahamaya Kutir**," in Padhdhar village, which serves as a beacon of hope for the entire Bhuj Taluka.

3. Key Initiative: Project Sunshine

Supported by the **SRF Foundation**, "Project Sunshine" remains our flagship program for the most vulnerable children.

- **Holistic Adoption:** We have continued our commitment to 50 slum children, providing them with a safe environment for growth.
- **Nutrition & Healthcare:** Beyond education, we provide regular nutritional supplements, medical check-ups, and hygiene kits to ensure physical well-being.
- **Educational Integration:** WDM facilitates formal school admissions and provides all necessary materials, including uniforms, books, and stationery.
- **Confidence Building:** Through our "**Daily Classes and other Activities**", these children engage in extracurricular activities that foster social skills and self-esteem.



4. Academic Excellence: Rural Education Support

Recognizing that rural students often lack academic guidance at home, our **Daily Classes** act as a vital bridge between school and home.

- **Free Academic Tuition:** WDM is one of the few NGOs providing daily academic support free of cost to prevent drop-outs.
- **Subject Mastery:** Special focus is placed on Mathematics, Science, and English, where students typically face the most challenges.
- **E-Speak Initiative:** This dedicated program enhances conversational English and digital literacy, preparing students for a globalized world.
- **Quantifiable Impact:** We are proud to report a sustained **90% improvement** in school attendance and academic performance among our regular students.



5. Digital Empowerment: Computer Training Classes

In the 21st century, computer literacy is as essential as reading and writing.

- **Bridging the Divide:** Our dedicated computer lab in Padhar ensures that rural children are not left behind in the digital revolution.
- **Curriculum:** Students are trained in hardware basics, file management, and the **MS Office suite** (Word, Excel, PowerPoint).
- **Internet Safety:** We educate students on "Internet Hygiene," teaching them how to use the web safely for research and learning.
- **Multilingual Typing:** Students practice typing speed and accuracy in both English and Gujarati.

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6. Secondary Education: Kodaki Classes

The transition to high school is a critical period where many students drop out. Our **Kodaki Classes** specifically target students in **Grades 9 and 10**.

- **Board Exam Preparation:** We provide rigorous coaching, including mock tests and paper-solving sessions, to ensure success in 10th-grade Board Exams.
- **Career Mentorship:** Beyond the syllabus, we guide students in selecting the right stream (Science, Commerce, or Arts) based on their aptitude.

7. Creative & Physical Growth: Sunday at Sunrise

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Education is not just about textbooks. Every Sunday, our campus transforms into a hub of creativity and energy.

- **Morning Energy:** The day begins with **Yoga and Meditation** to instill discipline and mental peace.
- **Creative Arts:** Activities include painting, craft-making, singing, and dancing.
- **Sportsmanship:** Team sports like kho-kho, and badminton teach leadership and resilience.
- **Value Education:** Storytelling sessions focus on moral values, civic sense, and Indian culture.

WDM plays a pivotal role in maintaining local traditions and strengthening the social fabric.

- **National Festivals:** Celebration of Republic Day and Independence Day to instill patriotism.
